The EYD Day is an EU-wide event putting constructive communication, positive news and results from the development countries in the spotlight. #### What is World's Best News?

World's Best News is a Danish news campaign, founded in 2010, working to raise awareness about the great progress taking place in the developing countries. World's Best News builds on a unique cooperation between the UN, the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs' development agency (Danida), over 100 Danish development organisations, and 100 corporate partners.

Through constructive journalism, we write and publish news and features from the developing countries. We focus on showing progress and solutions together with



positive nuances that are often neglected in mainstream media. Once a year, we publish a collection of our best news stories in a printed newspaper that we distribute nationwide through a great volunteer driven event.

The goal of the event is to communicate development in a new, constructive and appealing way to the broad public. In Denmark, we attain this by mobilizing volunteers from local NGOs and by collaborating with the private sector and the national media. The event is held in the morning at public places and passages as plazas, metro stations and bus stops. This way, we send people off to school and work with happy and surprising news. This year, the EU Commission has decided to expand the event to all EU member states that wish to join. So far, the initiative has expanded to five other countries in different versions: Ireland, Sweden, Norway, Finland and The Netherlands. In Denmark, we will have the event on September 11, but all EU participants are free to choose a date that makes sense locally. We recommend the month of September to use the occasion as a warm-up to the UN General Assembly. The EYD Day is an additional initiative to reach a broad and new audience, being complementary to the existing National Work Programmes.

#### **Three Levels of Engagement**

The World Best News-concept is very flexible and easy to up- or downscale. We have sketched out three possible versions that we can help you achieve:



**1.** WBN Max: The full concept with the newspaper distributed extensively by volunteers at a nationwide public event. The event is the culmination of cooperation between civil society organisations, private sector, and professional media channels. In addition, politicians and schools are invited to participate.

**2.** WBN Medium: A moderate version of the concept with focus on distributing the paper and creating a well-documented event, involving some partnerships.

**3.** WBN Mini: A tight version of the concept with focus on the creation of a simple and strategic media event, in which the paper is included. Online communication is key as warm up.

Our start-up in 2010 took about six months - so we know that it is possible, and we will help you get there.
